



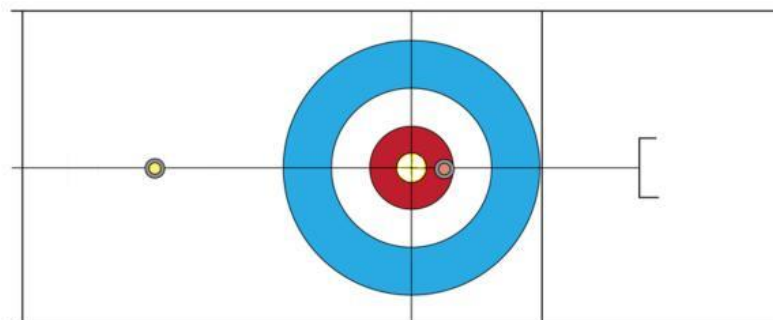

Mixed Doubles League Rules

Scottish Curling rules apply with the following amendments

- Each end starts with a stone being placed on the centre line in the free guard zone (this is a stone of the team without hammer), a second stone is placed on the centre line at the back of the 4ft circle (this is a stone of the team with hammer). Each team then throws 5 stones with one curler throwing the first and the final stone, the other throwing the middle 3 stones. No Stones can be removed from play until the fourth stone of an end.
- Scorecards must be completed for each game, clearly marking the players' full names and highlighting any substitutes used and left in the Mixed Doubles Scorecard Box.
- 2 points will be awarded for a win, 1 point for a peel and 0 points for a loss.
- Play will be 8 ends or the session bell.
- Substitutes must be of same gender they are replacing.
- Failure of a full team to turn up to a game will result in the opposition receiving 2 points, 4 ends and 6 shots and said offending team being liable for the cost of the ice.
- Failure of a single player to turn up will result in the opposition gaining 3 shots (1 shot for every 10 minutes late up to a maximum of 30 minutes). Severe weather will be taken into consideration.
